TOWN OF CAVENDISH - TRANSFER STATION INFORMATION

The Transfer Station is normally open the following days:

Wednesdays 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
Saturdays 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
Sundays 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Note: If a holiday falls on a day that the Transfer Station is normally open, this schedule is subject to change. Call the Town Office at 226-7291 for schedule during holiday weeks.

Permit Sticker Regulations

- 1. You must have a properly displayed Transfer Station sticker on your vehicle in order to use the Transfer Station. The sticker goes on the inside lower right-hand (passenger side) corner of the windshield. Transfer Station stickers are available at the Town Office.
- 2. Permit stickers are \$5.00 per vehicle.
- 3. Taxpayer, non-taxpayer residents and commercial enterprises must complete and sign a permit application form at the Town Office before being issued a Transfer Station sticker. Applications may also be done by mail. Applicants may be required to prove residence in Cavendish. The application form shall include: the year, make, model and color of the vehicle as well as the state of registration and license plate number. The application, including vehicle identification, must be complete and any fee due paid in full before a Transfer Station sticker will be issued.
- 4. Persons violating the rules and regulations of the Transfer Station Facility (as established by the Board of Selectmen and posted), will be subject to the revocation of the privilege of using the Transfer Station as well as other penalty as may be set forth in the Cavendish solid waste ordinance or relevant State statutes.
- 5. These stickers are to be used only to dispose of waste generated in the Town of Cavendish. Waste originating outside of the Town of Cavendish will not be accepted.

Disposal Fees & Tokens

- 1. Disposal tokens are available at the Town Office and Singleton's Store in \$1.50, \$3.00 and \$5.00 denominations. These tokens are to be used for the disposal of Household Trash and Special Wastes. **CASH IS NOT ACCEPTED AT THE TRANSFER STATION** checks or tokens only. You must pay fees at the time of disposal.
- 2. Fees for Household Trash: \$1.50 per fifteen gallon bag or equivalent
 - \$3.00 per thirty gallon bag or equivalent
- 3. Zero Sort Recycling there is no charge for depositing accepted items in the zero sort recycling container. See Zero Sort Recycling Guide for list of accepted items.

- 4. See Special Wastes Fee schedule for fees to dispose of other items. You may use tokens or write a check for these items.
- 5. Deposit waste items only in designated areas please ask attendant to direct you if you are not sure where to place items. It is necessary for you to notify the attendant BEFORE you attempt to place anything in the metal, tire, demo debris or burn pile areas.

Chipping, Compost & Burn Piles - Please ask attendant to direct you to the appropriate area.

- 1. Natural, unpainted brush, shrubbery, and christmas trees stripped of tinsel and all decorations may be placed in the **chipping bin**. No charge.
- 2. Yard debris, leaves, wreaths and garlands stripped of tinsel and all decorations, and uncooked fruit and vegetable remains may be placed in the **compost bin**. No charge.
- 3. Unpainted, unstained, untreated wood may be placed in the **burn pile**. No stumps, logs over 12" in diameter, plywood or particle board. No charge.

Unacceptable Items

The following items are not accepted for disposal in any area of the Transfer Station:

- 1. Urethane cartridges or tanks.
- 2. Partially filled spray paint, hair sprays, laquers, enamels, shellac and window cleaners.
- 3. Wood and metal finishing products.
- 4. Solvents, such as carburetor cleaners, auto wax and polish.
- 5. All anti-freeze.
- 6. Insecticides and lawn and garden products.
- 7. Sludges and human wastes.
- 8. Oils, including crankcase and cutting oils.
